Implementing rules: DTO.GEN.135 §(a)(2)

(a) A DTO shall no longer be entitled to provide some or all of the training specified in its declaration on the basis of that declaration, where one of the following occurs:

(1) the DTO has notified the competent authority of the cessation of some or all of the training activities covered by the declaration in accordance with point DTO.GEN.116(b);

(2) the DTO has not provided the training for more than 36 consecutive months.

(b) A DTO shall return approval certificates in accordance with point DTO.GEN.230(c) to the competent authority without delay:

(1) in case of cessation of training activities in accordance with point (a);

(2) in case of revocation in accordance with point ARA.GEN.350(da)(3) of Annex VI (Part-ARA).

Existing Acceptable Means of Compliance:

DGAC France Alternative Means of Compliance:

(a) When the DTO has not provided a training specified in its declaration and referred to in point DTO.GEN.110(a) for more than 36 consecutive months, it should, before providing the training again :

(1) Check that the training programme and associated documentation are up to date;

(2) Ensure that human and material resources are still adequate;

(3) Deliver a briefing to the relevant instructors to inform them about the content of the program, any specific elements, and possible changes to the programme, associated resources and environment since it was last delivered.

(b) When the DTO has not provided a training specified in its declaration and referred to in point DTO.GEN.110(b) for more than 36 consecutive months, it should submit a new declaration without mentioning this training. Before providing the training again, the DTO should :

(1) Submit the training programme to the competent authority;

(2) Obtain an approval from the competent authority;

(3) Submit a new declaration specifying the training programme.

(c) A commitment of completion of the briefing mentioned in (a)(3) should be recorded in the annual review report.
